The Kalamazoo River Community Advisory Group (CAG) allows people in the community to provide coordinated, local input to the decision-making process at the Allied Paper/Portage Creek/ Kalamazoo River Superfund Site. It is a forum for members to present and discuss community needs and concerns related to Superfund cleanup projects and explore areas of common ground in the community. The CAG assists the US Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) in making better decisions by providing the EPA a unique opportunity to hear and seriously consider community preferences for site cleanups. The CAG also works closely with Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), other government agencies and the broader community to ensure all community voices are engaged and heard in the Superfund cleanup and related concerns. The CAG consists of approximately 20 local residents representing a wide range of interests and viewpoints. Applications are reviewed and considered by all CAG members.

Expectations of CAG Members

The CAG meets every fourth Thursday at 6 PM. Members are expected to attend all monthly meetings, participate in committees, read materials and background information, and help to communicate with neighbors and others in the community. The CAG seeks to find common ground where possible, requiring all members to approach each other with respect and all issues with an open mind. Total time commitment is expected to be approximately 4 - 6 hours per month.
